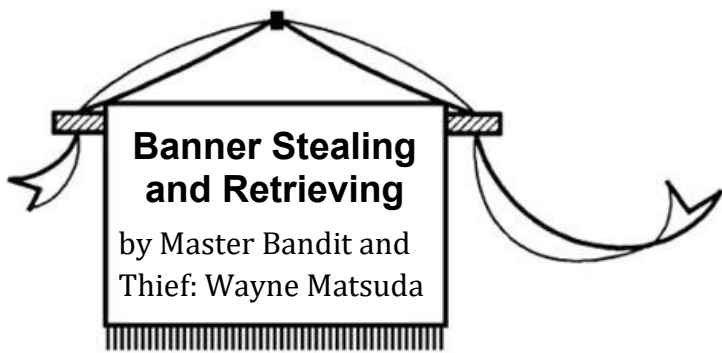
# **ROLLIN' WHEELS SQUARE DANCE CLASS**

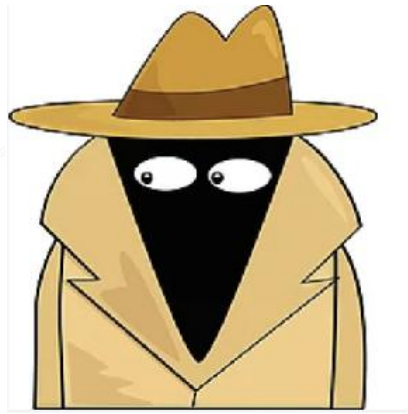

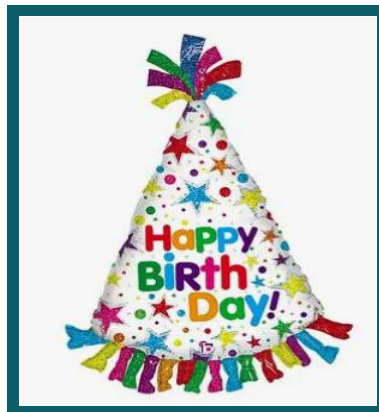

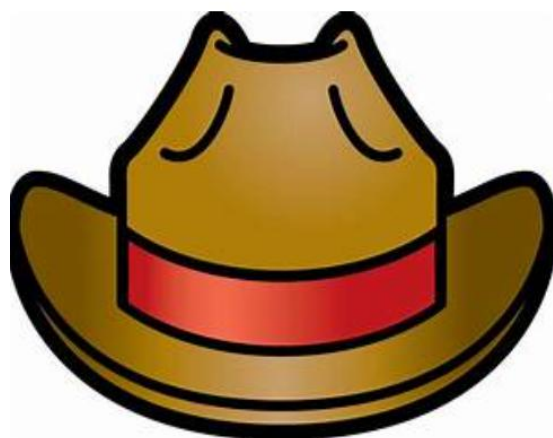
